SOUND POINT CALIFORNIA PRIVACY NOTICE

Effective Date: July 1, 2023

This Privacy Notice ("Notice") explains how Sound Point Capital Management, LP ("Sound Point Capital") and our affiliated entities (collectively, "Sound Point", "we", "us", or "our") may collect, use, and disclose personal information of California consumers. This Notice supplements our other privacy policies and notices, including our online **Privacy Policy**. In the event of a conflict between any other policy, statement, or notice and this Notice, this Notice will prevail as to California consumers.

Unless otherwise noted, the disclosures that describe how and why we collect, use, and disclose personal information also describe how we have collected, used, and disclosed personal information in the preceding twelve (12) months.

COLLECTION, USE, AND DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

"Personal information" means information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with you. Personal information does not include information that is publicly available, de-identified, or aggregated.

We may collect the following categories of personal information about California consumers. The personal information we collect about you may vary depending on the nature of your interactions with us and may not include all of the examples listed below.

- Prevent, investigate, identify, or otherwise take action regarding suspected or actual fraudulent or illegal activity, or any activity that violates or may violate applicable laws, regulations, or legal process and our policies. We may use the information to oversee adherence to our guidelines, to enforce our agreements with you, to prevent fraud and other prohibited or illegal activities and for other legally permissible purposes.
- Comply with applicable laws, regulations, or legal processes, as well as industry standards and our company policies.
- Evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets in which personal information held by us is among the assets transferred.

PERSONAL INFORMATION WE DISCLOSE

We may disclose personal information we obtain to:

- Our affiliates, including our subsidiaries and strategic business partners, who may use your information for purposes similar to the purposes for which we collect such information.
- Service providers and contractors that we retain to perform services on our behalf, including financial service providers, such as administrators, placement agents and prime brokers, who assist Sound Point as part of the ordinary course of servicing investment; marketing companies; customer support specialists; web hosting companies; fulfillment companies, such as companies that coordinate mailings; data analysis firms; and e-mail service providers.
- Professional advisers, including counsel, accountants and auditors, and persons acting in a fiduciary or representative capacity, such as an IRA custodian or trustee.
- Third parties if we believe disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request and enforce our agreements and policies.
- Service providers, contractors, and third parties to protect the security or integrity of the Sites or our services and products; to protect ourselves, our customers, or the public from harm or illegal activities; or to respond to an emergency which we believe in good faith requires us to disclose data to assist in preventing a death or serious bodily injury.
- Third parties in connection with a sale, merger, liquidation, dissolution, or sale or transfer of any portion of the assets of Sound Point, including negotiations of such transaction.

HOW LONG WE MAINTAIN YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We maintain the categories of personal information described above for as long as is necessary for the purposes described in this Notice or otherwise authorized by law. We generally keep the personal information for as long as one of the following apply: your personal information is reasonably necessary to manage our operations, to manage your relationship with us, or to satisfy another purpose for which we collected the information; your personal information is reasonably necessary to carry out a disclosed purpose that is reasonably compatible with the context in which the personal information was collected; your personal information is reasonably required to protect or defend our rights or property; or we are otherwise required or permitted to keep your personal information by applicable laws or regulations.

Where personal information is used for more than one purpose, we will retain it until the purpose with the latest period expires. For more information about our retention policies, please contact us using the contact details below.

SELLING AND SHARING PERSONAL INFORMATION

We do not Sell or Share for cross-context behavioral advertising the personal information of California Consumers, as those terms are defined in the California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA"). We do not have actual knowledge that we sell or share the personal information of consumers under 16 years of age.

YOUR RIGHTS AND HOW TO EXERCISE THEM

Submitting Requests Relating to Your Personal Information. If you are a resident of California, you have the right to submit certain requests relating to your personal information as described below. exercise any of these rights, please submit То а request to marketing@soundpointcap.com or call us at 1-833-217-6665. Please note that, if you submit a request to know, delete or correct, you may be asked to provide additional information for us to verify your identity. You may designate an authorized agent to make a request on your behalf; however, you may still need to verify your identity directly with us before your request can be processed.

Right to Know. You have the right to know what personal information we have collected about you, which includes:

- (1) The categories of personal information we have collected about you, including
 - a. The categories of sources from which the personal information was collected;
 - b. Our business or commercial purposes for collecting, selling, sharing, or disclosing personal information;
 - c. The categories of recipients to which we disclose personal information;
 - d. The categories of personal information that we sold or shared, and for each category identified, the categories of third parties to which we sold or shared that particular category of personal information; and
 - e. The categories of personal information that we disclosed for a business purpose, and for each category identified, the categories of recipients to which we disclosed that particular category of personal information.
- (2) The specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you.

Right to Delete Your Personal Information. You have the right to request that we delete personal information we collected from you, subject to certain exceptions.

Right to Correct Inaccurate Personal Information. If you believe that personal information we maintain about you is inaccurate, you have the right to request that we correct that information.

Right to Opt Out of Sales and Sharing of Personal Information. You have the right to opt out of the sale of your personal information, and to request that we do not share your personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising. We do not Sell or Share the Personal Information of California Consumers, as defined by the CCPA. For this reason, this right is not applicable.

Right to Limit Use and Disclosure of Sensitive Personal Information. We do not use or disclose sensitive personal information for purposes to which the right to limit use and disclosure applies. For this reason, this right is not applicable.

Rights Related to Automated Decision-Making. You have the right to opt out of automated decision-making, including profiling, that we use to evaluate certain personal aspects relating to your performance at work, economic situation, health, personal preferences, interests, reliability, behavior, location, or movements.
